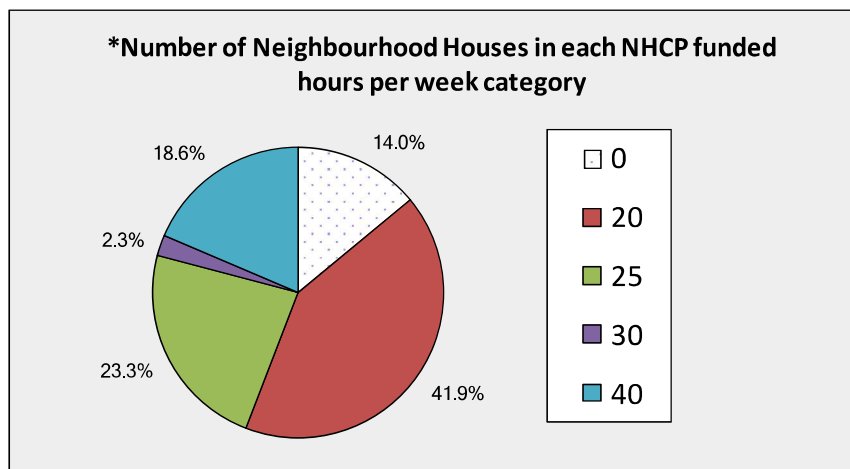


# SNAPSHOT—WESTERN REGION

This data is based on selected questions from the Neighbourhood Houses Survey 2016 administered by Neighbourhood Houses Victoria. These results are based on the 43 Neighbourhood Houses in the western region that responded to the survey.



Types of services requested from Network West	Response Percent
